



MINISTER'S MOMENT

The month of November gives us several opportunities to fall back in order to go forward. The first Sunday of November is All Saints' Day, and we remember saints through the ages whose examples contributed to our faith journeys. Veterans Day is the second Sunday, and we commemorate the brave soldiers who set aside their own comfort to serve their country. The fourth Thursday of the month is Thanksgiving, when we give thanks for the spiritual and material gifts bestowed by God -- and we celebrate this bounty with extra good food and fellowship.

As I give thanks for God's good gifts, I find that I have more opportunities to think about my relationship with the Giver. Am I willing to be as generous with God as God is with me? Invariably, I find that I fall short as I consider these questions, and I fall back and pray for forgiveness. Through God's forgiveness, I am realigned and recharged to move forward on the faith journey. This pattern of falling back to go forward will probably continue until God calls me home.

In the meantime, this imperfect person is deeply loved by a perfect Creator. And so are you.
