MINISTER'S MOMENT

The picture to the right is of the white lace that is sometimes hung in the sanctuary on Easter. It represents the linen shroud that remained in the empty tomb when Jesus was resurrected. Betrayal, cruelty, desertion, trials and a gruesome death could not quash the ability of God to restore hope to the world. Regardless of the intentions of the tyrants who ruled when Jesus walked the earth, they did not prohibit God's power to resurrect the Savior.

The empty shroud is especially meaningful this year. After two years of holding Easter services in the parking lot, we will celebrate Christ's resurrection in the sanctuary on April 17th. The isolation that has been an undercurrent of two consecutive Easters will be left behind in contagion's tomb. The Choir will sing, puppets will play, and fulsome fellowship will be restored. We will proclaim through scripture and song the faithfulness of our Lord.

One of my favorite Easter hymns is "Thine Is the Glory," whose melody was composed by George Handel and whose lyrics were written by Edmund L. Budry and R. Birch Hoyle. The lyrics encapsulate my thoughts this Easter:

Lo! Jesus meets us, risen from the tomb; Lovingly he greets us, scatters fear and gloom. Let the church with gladness hymns of triumph sing, For our Lord now liveth; death has lost its sting. Thine is the glory, risen, conquering Son, Endless is the victory thou o'er death hast won.

I hope that you will sing the song—loudly—with me on Easter. Blessed to be on the journey with you,
