


FEASTING AND FESTIVITIES

MINISTER'S MOMENT

Folks who attended the November 28th service, or watched it online, saw the new banners that hang on the narrow walls behind the organ and the pulpit. The materials for the banners were purchased in January 2020, and the original idea was to hang them during Lent that year. When the virus arrived in Iowa in March 2020 and worship methods changed, the banner materials were set aside as we learned how to offer services online and through Drive-In Church.

It's almost two years later, and we are meeting inside the sanctuary and online. The banners are being displayed in their intended locations. The different colored ribbons are abstract representations of the life of Jesus. The silver metallic strip in the center indicates the light that emanated from the Bethlehem star that guided the shepherds to the Savior.

God guided the shepherds to the Savior, and God has guided us, too. The Holy One has provided the methods and means for us to continue to adore our Creator and serve creation. Last Christmas Eve, we celebrated Christ's birth in the parking lot. This year, angels, shepherds, and Wise Ones will once again trek through the church to welcome the Baby King (see page 3).

Finances were uncertain at the end of 2020. But, because of God's leading, the Board's decisions, the Financial Team's perseverance, and your generosity, next year's proposed budget looks promising.

The pandemic resulted in a temporary reduction in the usage of Glen Echo's building, but the Board voted to enter into a space-sharing agreement with River Valley Disciples. The rental arrangement provides this new Disciples of Christ congregation with a stable place to meet, and it enhances the ministry to God's people that originates at the corner of Beaver and Douglas.

As Advent comes and we enter this new church year, we have ample reason to give thanks to God. We can trust the Creator and welcome Jesus, the incarnate expression of God's love, into our hearts with hope.




DECEMBER DOINGS

\$200 was collected for the Disciples of Christ's Thanksgiving Offering. These funds support our denomination's colleges and universities, as well as our seminaries and Divinity Houses.

River Valley Disciples is a new Disciples of Christ congregation that is looking for a place where they can meet consistently. Pastor Sheldon Henderson talked with members of Glen

Echo's Board in October to discuss the possibility of gathering at Glen Echo. At the November 9th Board Meeting, our church leadership voted to approve a space-sharing arrangement with River Valley Disciples.

After consultations with our Insurance Agent and other parties, a six-month lease agreement was written by our resident paralegal and vetted by our Board. The agreement will be re-evaluated after the initial period, with the hope of entering



into a growing partnership with RVD. This new congregation is financially supported by the Region, and they will contribute \$320 per month for the use of space at Glen Echo.

Beginning December 5th, River Valley Disciples will meet in the lounge on Sunday mornings from 9:00—9:45. This mission-minded congregation may also use the kitchen to prepare meals for various ministries in the community. Future endeavors with both congregations may involve joint Outreach and Youth Group projects.
